ABOUT THE PCE SRC

SRC in full means Students' Representative Council. This remains the only legitimate representative of the student body and it is regulated by a constitution promulgated by the Academic board. The members of the SRC Executive Committee are elected by the student body. The Patron for this council is the Dean of Students Affairs.

Therefore, SRC is a legitimate body that works on behalf of the college and the students at the same time. The SRC play the role of the Principal and the interest of the students. Hence, the motto of the SRC in Latin is "operatur in vorbis" which means working for you. Meaning that without you, there is no SRC. Every student of Presbyterian College of Education is a member of the SRC.

DUTIES OF THE SRC

- Promoting the vision and mission statement of the college.
- Working with the students, faculty, staff and management on activities and policies relating to the overall wellbeing and interest of the student community.
- In accordance with the statute of the college, nominate student representatives to serve on appropriate boards and committees.
- Communicating the views of students to the appropriate body or bodies.
- Coordinating the social, cultural, intellectual, recreational and sporting activities of the students in the college.
- Maintaining contact and promoting vibrant and developmental relationships with past students of the college.
